- Sealed Lead Acid Maintenance Free Batteries (10 year design life) housed in TWO separate cabinets to the UPS to provide a back up time of approximately 60 minutes SYSTEM TIME at full load.
- 30 Minutes battery backup per UPS
- Cabinet Dimensions Each: 750mm (w) x 750mm (D) x 1800mm (H)


