1. Food Quality Control


1.1. Ensure quality control and food safety of produce (i.e, food transport inspection, product inspection, product testing, mass verification, and food condemnations) in accordance with food quality and food safety policies, procedures and relevant regulations. 1.2 Communicate and liaise with producers, market agents and other stakeholders regarding inspection findings. 1.3 Compile and submit a daily report of all product rejections to QA Supervisor, Trading Hall Supervisors / Manager and Market Agents. Conduct follow-up inspections thereafter. 1.4 Ensure the correct use of calibrated testing equipment during the course of duties and report deviations to Supervisor. 1.5 Develop quality expertise in the fresh produce and other applicable foodstuffs including knowledge of plant pests and disease. 1.6 Develop basic understanding and application in job-related technical areas of post-harvest physiology, product handling and storage practices, cold chain and temperature management. (Daily and as required)

2. Food Safety Testing Compliance Monitoring & Control

2.1 Draw samples for food quality and food safety testing and submit to laboratory in accordance with sampling procedures; 2.2 Interpret and report laboratory test results to the relevant stakeholders. Take appropriate corrective action based on test findings. (Weekly or as required)

3. Supplier Food Safety Profiling & Stakeholder Engagement

3.1 Liaise with JM food suppliers to obtain relevant food safety and quality information and capture on the sales processing system; and continually update the Supplier Food Safety Profiles. 3.2 Participate in training and advise stakeholders on quality control, food hygiene and food safety. 3.3 Attend industry related stakeholder meetings related to job function when required. 3.4 Investigate food complaints received. Ensure Corrective and preventive action is taken and feedback is given to the complainant. 3.5 Develop understanding and application in food safety standards and food safety management systems. (Daily / Weekly or as required)

4. Food Hygiene Monitoring, Control & Improvement

- 4.1 Perform hygiene inspections of JM facilities and food premises on the market relating to ensure food safety compliance. 4.2 Perform pest control monitoring and reporting to minimize risk of food damaged and contamination.
- 4.3 Conduct follow-up inspection on decayed products held in storage to ensure timeous food waste removal. (Monthly and as required)
